Dates

Dates for Spring 2008:

- Arrive in Mexico on Friday, January 18
- Orientation on Saturday, January 19
- Start of classes on Monday, January 21
- Vacation week from Saturday, March 1 to Sunday, March 9
- Last day of class on Friday, April 18

Dates for Fall 2008:

- Arrive in Mexico on Friday, August 29
- Orientation on Saturday, August 30
- Start of classes on Monday, September 1
- Vacation week from Saturday, October 11 to Sunday, October 19
- Last day of class on Friday, November 28

Cost

Semester:

Program Fee is \$4,500 for ISU students. Non-ISU students pay an additional \$500 fee to cover extra administrative costs.

Program fees include

NOT included in program fees are

- airfare to and from Mexico
- incidentals
- individual travel
- designated ISU fees
- 10% of net ISU tuition
